


## CONTEXT: PREZODE MEMBERS DISTRIBUTION




#### CONTEXT: STRATEGIC AGENDA

- These feedbacks helped to define the PREZODE Strategic Agenda







- Priority research programmes and equipment (Programmes et équipements prioritaires de recherche, PEPR):
- ❖ 5 work packages (WP) over the next 5 years, to enable **French** research teams to develop innovative programmes in different fields.

**WP5:** Scientific coordination on zoonosis emergence prevention at national and international scale. This WP aims at proposing prospective studies to support decision makers.

Action 5: The funded projects of different WPs including the activities conducted in WP5 are expected to use and generate a wealth of data. Data management, interoperability, and accessibility will be addressed here.








### DOUBLE DIAMOND METHOD


