



Drafting and reviewing questions based on One Health core 1. competency domains for the certification examination.

- Establishing eligibility criteria for trainees seeking to sit for the 2 One Health Certification Examination, including, for example, previously passing a mentored experiential learning activity coordinated through a practicum course or internship project, and experiences that can only be attested through direct observation.
- Establishing pass/fail thresholds for performance in the 3. certification examination.
- Sensitizing accrediting bodies, professional organizations, and 4. potential employers of pre-service trainees and supervisors of in-service trainees; and convening authors to submit a proposal for a Study Guide for One Health Certificate examination.
