# ABOUT OHSEA IN PRACTICE

The OHSEA project aims to create synergies and consolidate the One Health (OH) initiatives in South East Asia, notably by strengthening its environmental dimension.

The aim is to move towards a shared understanding of the knowledge, representations and values carried in the OH approach by the various key players (citizens, communities, practitioners, researchers, decision-makers); to strengthen the skills of the latter in order to better understand the emergence of infectious diseases and to prevent tomorrow's health crises; and to propose tools to enable the implementation of this integrated approach to the three types of health (human, animal and ecosystem) in the diversity of the social, environmental and economic situations of the countries of South East Asia.



## IT INCLUDES THE FUNDING OF : 3 COMPONENTS



### 20 training topics leading to 23 training events

Built in partnership with academic actors, research institutes and the private sector, mobilising more than 500 participants, and leading to building around 100 missions.



### 16 regional research projects

From at least across 2 to 3 countries from Southeast Asia, leading to the signature of 34 agreements and amendments.



### An analysis

On the prospects of the One Health approach for the Asia-Pacific region and the concrete implementation of the guidelines of the Global Plan of Action for One Health 2022-2026 of the WHO-WOAH-FAO-UNEP quadripartite.
